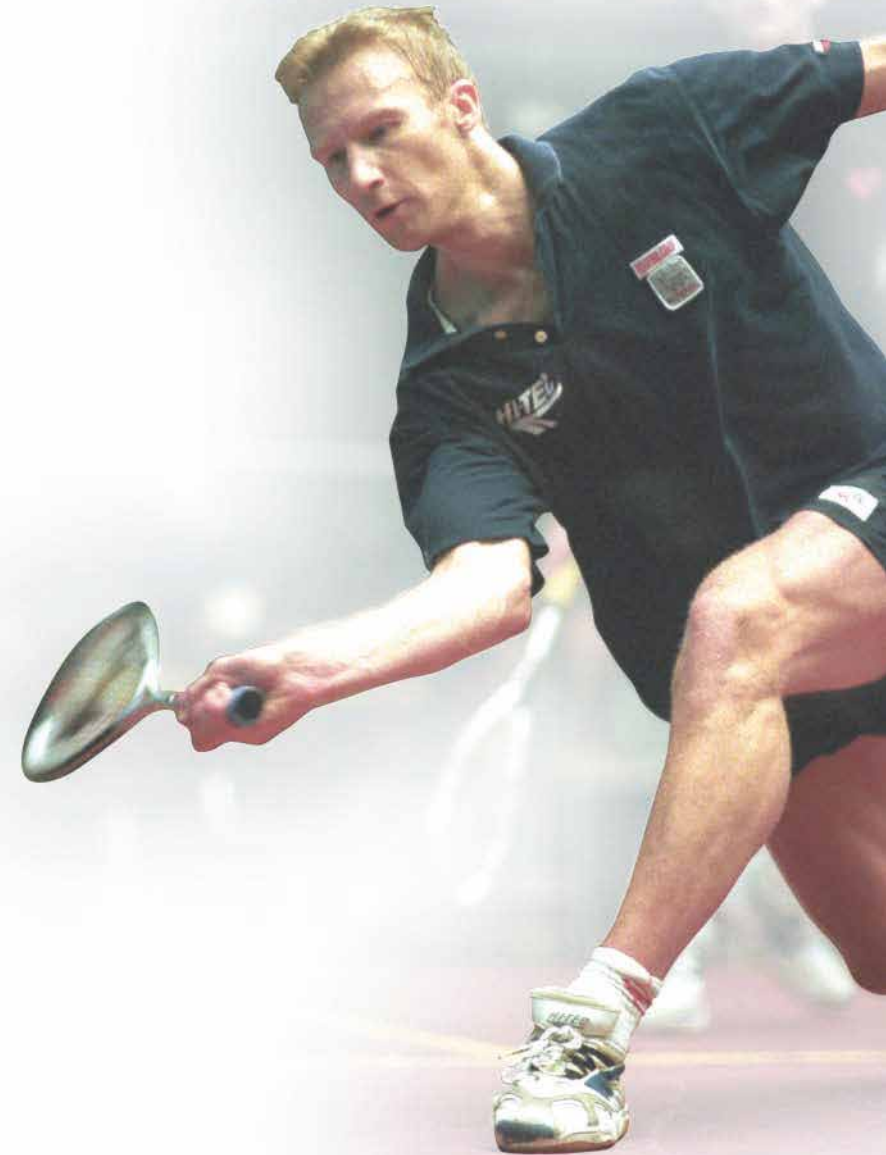

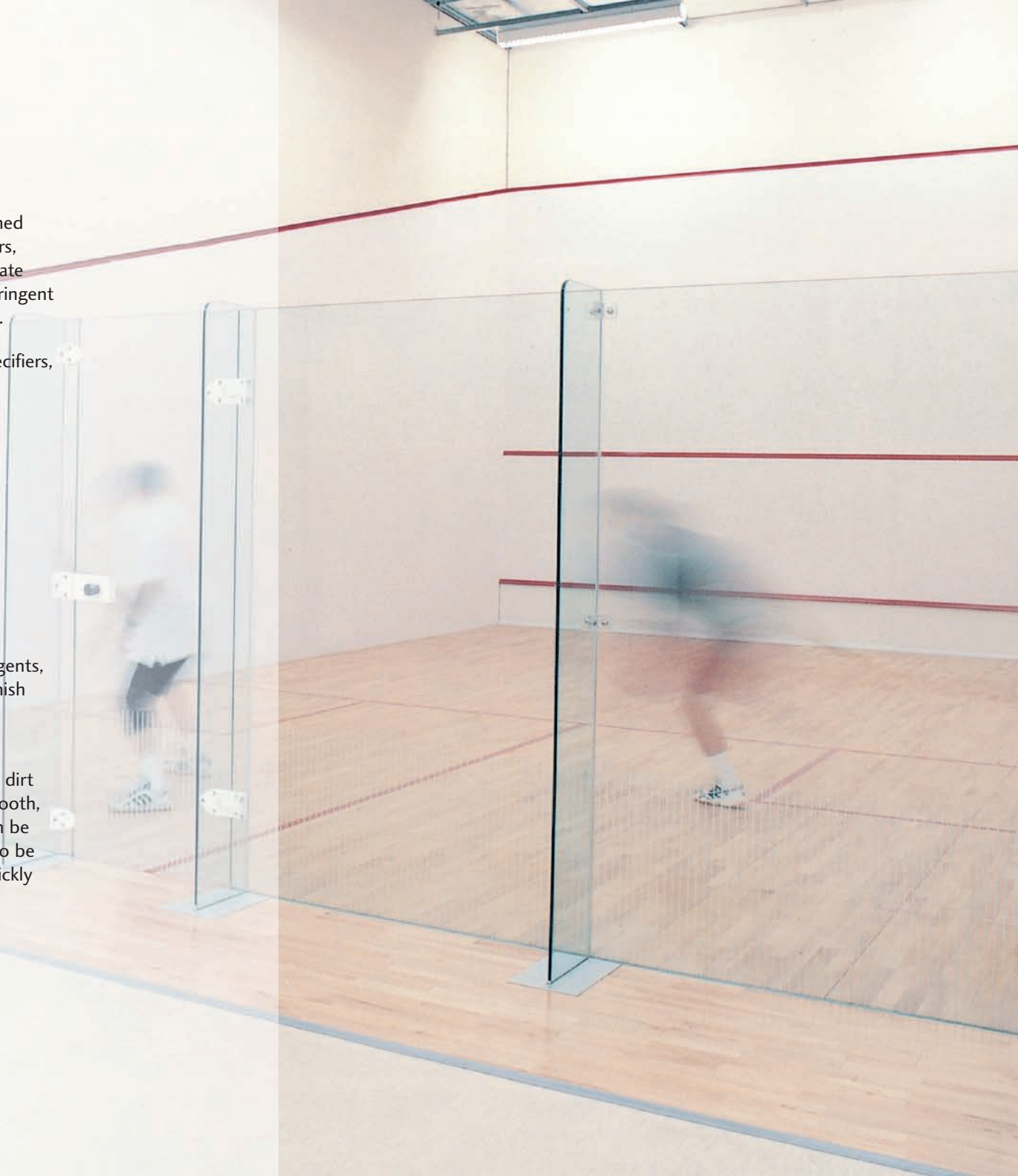

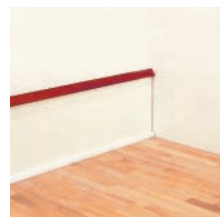

To complete the package, for both Armourcoat and Armourcolor squash courts, low-maintenance pre-shaped, extruded plastic Out-Of-Play lines and 'tins' (front wall sounding board kits) are available in three colours to complement whichever plaster colour you choose. Armourcoat accessories are approved by the SRA.



Armourcoat Sounding Boards and Out-Of-Line systems can be installed in existing courts or as new-build with equal ease in a fraction of the usual time, requiring no painting and giving clear indication of a ball falling out of play.

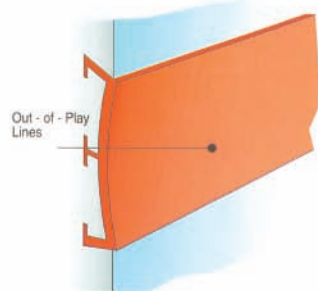

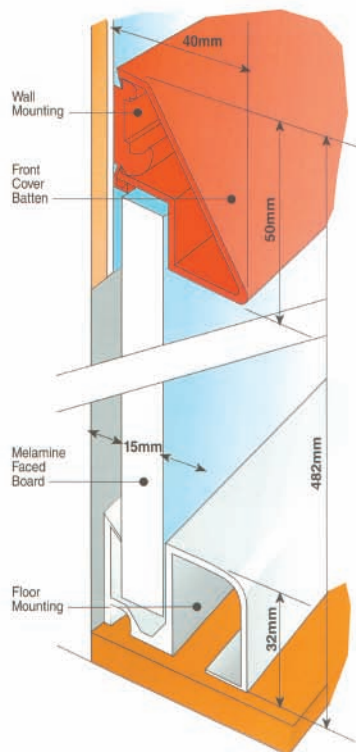

Traditionally, walls in courts like these were surfaced in conventional renders, which were often painted to achieve the dark colours (required for use with a white ball), which inevitably led to cracking and peeling. Using pigmenting techniques developed in our decorative surfaces division, we have pioneered a unique range of self-coloured products, which serve the dual function of combining great strength and strong pigmentation, suitable for:

- Fives
